

MOULDY FIGS OF AUSTIN

We the undersigned agree to participate jointly in a limited for-profit venture as follows:

1. The name under which we will do business is Mouldy Figs of Austin.
2. The purpose of this enterprise is to further the performance in Austin of traditional or Dixieland jazz music, excluding, among other things, Country-Western music and all noise erupting from any electric instrument or device whatsoever.
3. More specifically, the immediate intention is to rent the Creek Theatre, 705 East 6th Street, and hire The Old Original Traditional Dixieland Jazz Band each Saturday night for about 10 weeks, beginning August 28, 1976.
4. Each participant will share in the gains or losses of this enterprise in the proportion that that person's investment bears to the total invested, as shown below.
5. An item of initial expense is the reimbursement to Eugene Wisdom of \$300.00 for rent paid for the months of May and June on 408 East 6th Street.
6. Group decisions will be made in accordance with votes cast in proportion to amounts invested, as shown below. A steering committee, composed of Linalice Carey, Frank Mesich and Eugene Wisdom, will carry out such duties as are delegated to it by the whole group.
7. Any participant may withdraw from the enterprise at any time and receive a share of the net worth of the enterprise at that time in the proportion that that person's investment bears to the total invested, as shown below.
